

4 of our wonderful Year 5 children spoke with a reporter from BBC Radio Cornwall to help support our fundraising campaign for London.



















Turtles class have had fun thinking of onomatopoeia words that describe a sound. They will use these to help write a sonnet about Beowulf!



This is some of the lovely printing practice from Basking Shark Class; they were designing printing tiles of iconic London buildings to use in their Blitz prints.







A big well done to our Year 6 athletes who were amazing in the track and field events today against all other Falmouth schools.








Girls Football Team
